

Obituary Outline Form

Give a Little History

1. Start by stating the deceased's full name. The names of the deceased's parents or guardian. Where was the deceased born or grew up. What City/State? How many siblings (brothers or sisters) did the deceased have?, etc.

Give a Little Background

2. **Briefly mention the person's history in chronological order;**
example: What Church did the deceased belong to? What High School/College did the deceased attend?, and date of graduation.

- List any personal hobbies and tributes.
- Was the deceased married? If so, give the date of marriage.
- Where did the deceased work? Also, list any employment, educational, or extracurricular achievements.

Names of the Family Members

3. **Who does the deceased leave behind?** (for example):

- Loving husband/wife, children, brothers, sisters, quantity of grandchildren (*you do not have to list names*).
- Names of; aunts, uncles, cousins and friends. (*And a host of...*)

The goal is to try to make writing the biography of your loved one as accurate and smooth as possible.
